Teaching and Learning Management

of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of Academic Year B.E. 2565

With reference to the announcement of Mahidol University on the opening of Mahidol University Premise in Salaya Campus under the Measure to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) dated 25<sup>th</sup> June B.E. 2565. In accordance, Government Agencies have considered easing the restrictions and opening up areas to be able to the place to manage education teaching, exams, training, or any activity with a large number of participants by strictly implementing the disease prevention measures prescribed by the government.

To ensure that the teaching and learning management of the 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester of Academic Year B.E. 2565 is in accordance with the measures to prevent the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19), by virtue of Article 14 of Mahidol University Regulation on the Administration of Mahidol University International College, College of Management and College of Music B.E. 2553, the Dean of CMMU has made the announcement on Teaching and Learning Management in 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester of Academic Year B.E. 2565 as follows:

Article 1: Permission to use the premises to manage learning, teaching, and activities as usual.

Article 2: Teaching and learning and exams management shall be in a classroom format (On-site 100%) for the maximum benefit for the learning quality of students. However, if a student has an emergency situation that prevents them from attending classes for some weeks, such as being infected with coronavirus or having travel restrictions. Students may submit a request to study in a hybrid format, with the approval of the Program Chair and the Program Director.

Article 3: Teaching materials must be used in a digital file format only by uploading documents to the College's E-Learning system in order to reduce the use of paper documents and conserve the environment.

Article 4: Instructors, students and outsiders who come to the college must wear a mask at all times in order to reduce the risk of spreading the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).
